The Flywheel Project Journey

JP's inspiration for the Flywheel Project came from his work building Black Lab Sports. His idea was to create opportunities for up and coming leaders to be immersed in critical hands-on experiential learning experience. If he could provide these opportunities through strategic partnerships with a network of companies in the sports and business landscape, he could help up and coming leaders learn by having applicable roles and responsibilities in a diverse portfolio of organizations from startups to well established enterprises. Flywheel Project is an enhanced application based learning platform connecting experienced hard working talent to their future dreams.

The Flywheel Project was founded in 2017 and hosted the first Turn with two students in the spring and nine students in the summer of 2018! Since then the Flywheel Project has hosted a cohort of students each summer and fall, including during the 2020 pandemic. In response to the Marshall Fire that affected 1000+ people the Flywheel Project hosted "Project Phoenix", a community focused event that provided the victims with necessary items for daily life provided with the help of our generous community supporters.

As a catalyst for a better future, Flywheel Project develops tomorrow's business leaders and entrepreneurs through innovative project-based and experiential learning. Flywheel Project connects leading companies with up and coming leaders who are equipped to make an immediate contribution and positive impact.

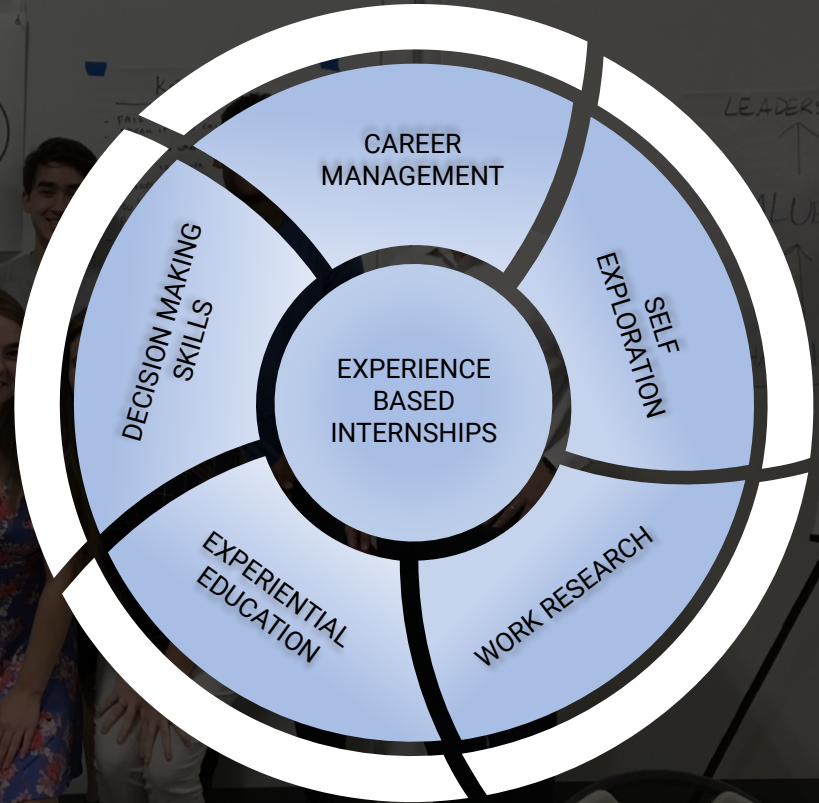
Reach and Impact

What is a *Turn*?

A *Turn* is what the Flywheel Project calls our experience based internship program. When a student participates in a *Turn*, they are provided opportunities to be immersed in critical hands-on experiential learning experience.

- Internship opportunities are built through strategic partnerships with a network of purpose led companies with headquarters or branch location in Colorado.
- Up and coming student leaders will learn by having applicable roles and responsibilities in a diverse portfolio of organizations from startups to well established enterprises.
- Flywheel Project provides additional support to students and employers by managing the communication of the internship responsibilities and work completed, coaching students to prepare them and help bring value while in their role, and acting as the main point of contact for companies during the internship.
- Turns last eight (8) weeks and are hosted in the Summer and Fall, with applications opening in the fall of the previous year.

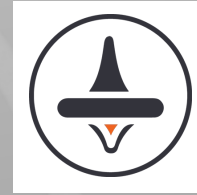


Flywheel Project Growth Fund
